2011 WEST COAST RULES & CONDITIONS

Pre-Registration/Entries:

- Mail completed entry form, one per horse/rider combination, with payment or open check postmarked by June 15th. Pre-Registration does not require entry into a class. Pre-Registration includes copies of CURRENT 2011 owner and rider association membership cards (NRHA/HCBC), horse registration papers or proof of ownership, signed declaration of eligibility, NRHA competition license (if applicable). Post entries received after June 15th will be accepted with a \$60 post entry fee. **Pre-Registered entries received prior to June 15th enable us to process entries in advance and results in less confusion and delay to all upon arrival.** Post entries will be accepted until 5:00pm the night BEFORE the class is to take place for Friday/Saturday/Sunday classes, and 8:00am Thursday morning for Thursday classes. Draws will not be posted online but day sheets will be available at the show office. Classes scratched PRIOR to the draw being posted will receive a full refund. **NO REFUNDS ONCE THE CLASS DRAW HAS BEEN POSTED!**
- Open to all breeds of horses and caliber of riders.
- Class eligibility is based on the rider's and/or the horse's earnings as of January 1st of the current NRHA year. See WCRA high point rule book for WCRA class conditions.
- All fees are made payable to West Coast Classic in Canadian funds only.
- Entrants will be required to sign a declaration of eligibility.
- All stalled horses must be entered in a minimum of one class. No haul-ins will be allowed for horses not entered in a class.

Arrival:

- Exhibitors may arrive anytime after 4:00pm on Wednesday, July 13th. Any early arrivals must be prearranged, based on availability. Contact the show manager for more information and to arrange early arrivals.

Stabling:

- Stalls will be assigned on a first come, first served basis. Completed stall reservation forms must be post marked by June 15th in order to guarantee space. Stalls will not be reserved unless paid for in advance, no open cheques for stalls will be accepted. After June 15th stalls are not refundable.

Office fee:

- A \$40.00 office fee must be paid with each entry.

RV/Trailer Hook up:

- RV/Trailer hookups are available at Chilliwack Heritage Park for \$20.00 per night and include power only. Showers and washrooms are available on site. All RV/Trailers will be required to display camping registration card (provided by show office) in a visible location during the show as proof of camping registration.

Animal control:

- Dogs are to remain on a leash and must be kept under control at all times. Dogs can cause safety hazards. Please be attentive in high traffic areas.

Parking:

- Please park in designated parking areas only. Any vehicles parked in an un-authorized area will be moved at the owner's expense. **No vehicles or trailers are permitted to park for longer than 10 minutes to unload at the back of the stabling area.**

Returned cheques:

- Cheques returned or held by the bank will be charged a \$50 fee. Accounts will have 7 days to be paid in full by cash or money order or they will be reported to the NRHA for further disciplinary action.

Competitors:

- By participating in the West Coast Classic, all competitors agree to abide by the rules of the show and the governing bodies, NRHA/WCRA, and acknowledge that horses are dangerous animals and can be hazardous. By participating in the competition with this knowledge of the danger involved the competitor agrees to accept any and all risks of injury or death.

Behavior and Conduct:

- No mistreatment of any animal will be tolerated! Any competitor, owner or trainer found to be abusing their horse in any way will be IMMEDIATELY disqualified from the competition and reported to the NRHA for disciplinary procedures.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated! Any action of disrespect, deceit or fraud directed to show management, grounds crew, show representatives or judges will result in disqualification from competition and removal from the facility. Individuals accused of unsportsmanlike conduct will be subject to the disciplinary procedures set forth by the National Reining Horse Association in Article A of the handbook.

Equipment:

- After each work, bits will be dropped and viewed by the judge or designate.
- In classes where running martingales are permitted, rein stoppers must be used.
- Equipment must be used as stated in the WCRA rulebook, unless otherwise specified. WCRA rulebook is available online at www.wcra.info

General information:

- All reining classes will be judged according to the 2011 WCRA rulebook except where designated as NRHA classes, which will be judged according to the 2011 NRHA rulebook. Wherever possible WCRA follows NRHA rules. The WCRA rulebook is available at www.wcra.info or by contacting the Show Secretary.
- West Coast Classic show committee will select patterns. The patterns will be posted a minimum of one hour prior to the start of the competition. Patterns are also available at www.wcra.info or www.nrha.com
- Payouts are according to NRHA rules. Show will retain 50% of entry fees. Any payouts in WCRA classes will be made in accordance to NRHA rules.
- All Champions and Reserve Champions must report to the photographer for sponsor photos.
- West Coast Classic reserves the right to cancel, postpone or re-schedule this event without notice at any time prior to the contest and without liability to West Coast Classic or WCRA. Entry fees will be returned in the case of cancellation.
- Website posting is for information purposes only and is considered "draft only". In the case of a difference between the website and the show office, the show office information will be final.
- All protests and complaints must be submitted to the show committee in writing.

Class Conditions:

- DERBY: Horses aged 4/5/6 years old. Horses are to be shown one handed.
- FUTURITY: Horses aged 3 years old. Horses maybe shown one or two handed in any legal bridal.
- NRHA CLASSES: See current NRHA rulebook
- WCRA CLASSES: See current WCRA rulebook

2011 WCRA DECLARATION OF STATUS

Beginner A, Beginner B, Beginner NRHA Pattern: I meet the Non Pro criteria as set out in the current NRHA Rule Book and,

Beginner A: I have not won a High Point Championship or Reserve Championship in Beginner A, Beginner B, Beginner NRHA, Youth, or Beginner Rider Open, and have not ridden a horse to a Championship or Reserve Championship in Beginner Horse Open, nor competed in a class that required a non modified NRHA pattern to be ridden one-handed.

Beginner B: I have not won a High Point Championship or Reserve Championship in Beginner B, Beginner NRHA pattern, Youth or Beginner Rider Open, and have not ridden a horse to a Championship or Reserve Championship in Beginner Horse Open, nor competed in a class that required a non modified NRHA pattern to be ridden one-handed.

Beginner NRHA: I have not won a High Point Championship or Reserve Championship in Beginner NRHA and have never placed 1st, prior to the current year, in a class that required a non modified NRHA pattern be ridden one-handed.

Beginner Reiner Open: I have less than \$500 lifetime earnings in any type or class of reining competitions at the start of the year.

Beginner Horse Open: The horse that I have entered in this class has less than \$500 lifetime earnings in any type or class of reining competitions at the start of the year, regardless of ownership.

Rookie: I meet the Non Pro and Rookie criteria as set out in the current NRHA Rule Book.

Novice Horse – Open & Non Pro: The horse and rider meet the criteria as set out in the current NRHA Rule Book

Ltd. Non Pro: I meet the Ltd. Non Pro criteria as set out in the current NRHA Rule Book.

Non Pro: I meet the Non Pro criteria as set out in the current NRHA Rule Book.

Ltd. Open: I meet the Ltd. Open criteria as set out in the current NRHA Rule Book.

It is the responsibility of each rider who signs this declaration to be aware of all official earnings of the horse and rider as well as all non-recorded reining earnings for eligibility for classes entered into, and to read the applicable rules. I understand that a false declaration will result in forfeiture of all money and prizes won at this show in applicable classes.
